### CCOA Summer Programme 2026:

#### Online Hate in Focus – Preventing and Countering Antisemitism through Research, Policy and Practice

#### Programme Overview

CCOA is launching its 2026 Summer Programme — a two-month capacity-building initiative building on the expertise of the network and designed to strengthen skills, knowledge, and applied practice across a diverse range of professional backgrounds. The programme focuses on scaling impact in addressing online antisemitism and broader forms of online hate within the wider anti-hate ecosystem. Combining expert input with practical application, the programme supports participants in deepening their understanding of current challenges and translating evidence-based insights into practice.

It accommodates different levels of engagement and experience, allowing participants either to attend individual sessions or to follow a more guided pathway with opportunities for reflection and the exploration of European prevention and counter-strategies aimed at overcoming fragmented efforts across Europe.

Across a series of expert-led sessions and workshops, the programme will explore key themes such as detecting and responding to online threats, understanding emerging narratives and platform dynamics, engaging with regulatory frameworks, and strengthening support for affected individuals and communities.

Alongside the core sessions, participants interested in deeper engagement will have the opportunity to exchange ideas, contribute perspectives from their own work or research, and explore possibilities for collaboration, including developing short written outputs or practice-based reflections.

#### The summer programme combines:

- Interactive expert-led sessions
- Peer exchange and discussion
- practice-oriented reflection and optional collaborative engagement

No specialist or technical background is required. The programme values local experience, community knowledge, and practitioner perspectives alongside action, research and policy insights.

#### Participants will:

- Develop practical understanding of how online antisemitism and harmful narratives emerge and evolve
- Strengthen their capacity to respond to digital harms
- Gain insights into current regulatory and platform-related developments
- Exchange perspectives with peers across Europe
- (Optional) Contribute to collaborative discussions, reflections, or written outputs linked to the programme themes

- Detection and prevention of online antisemitism
- Emerging antisemitic narratives, codes, and memes
- Engagement with regulatory frameworks
- Victim support, safety, and resilience
- Translating research on online governance into policy and practice
- Cross-country exchange and European perspectives

## Participation Pathways

The CCOA Summer Programme is open and flexible, allowing participants to engage in different ways:

### 1. Open Participation

Participants may attend individual sessions based on their interests, with no additional requirements. (registration per session via the links provided).

### 2. Practice & Reflection Track

Participants who wish to follow a more structured pathway may opt into the Practice & Reflection Track. This track supports deeper engagement with the programme themes through participation and guided reflection (including a certificate of completion).

This track includes:

- attendance to the majority of sessions
- participation in the kick-off, and final reflection session (28 May and 30 July)
- completion of an assignment by 9 July

This track is designed for participants who wish to deepen their understanding of the programme themes through structured participation and guided reflection.

Participants on this track will also have the opportunity to further engage with the content, for example by contributing reflections, exploring ideas for collaboration, or developing short written outputs linked to their area of interest.

At the end of the programme, participants will receive a **certificate of completion** recognising their engagement, reflective work, and applied learning throughout the programme.

### 3. Engage & Collaborate (Optional Pathway)

Participants who wish to build on the programme discussions are warmly invited to explore opportunities for further engagement and collaboration.

This pathway is designed for those who would like to:

- Discuss concrete ideas for collaboration emerging from the sessions (CCOAs accelerate programme)
- Connect with peers and practitioners working on similar topics
- Develop or share practice-based insights, research, or perspectives

Participants working on relevant topics may also express interest in contributing a short “dispatch” (a concise, accessible piece based on their research, policy, education, or practice work) through the CCOA network. This would be subject to a prior exchange with the CCOA research team, to explore alignment, suitability, and possible formats, as well as the appropriate editorial process. In cases where dispatches are developed and published, remuneration may be provided in line with CCOA practice. Those interested are warmly invited to approach the team towards the end of the programme or following specific sessions. The CCOA team will be happy to discuss ideas, explore potential collaboration, and facilitate appropriate connections and next steps.
